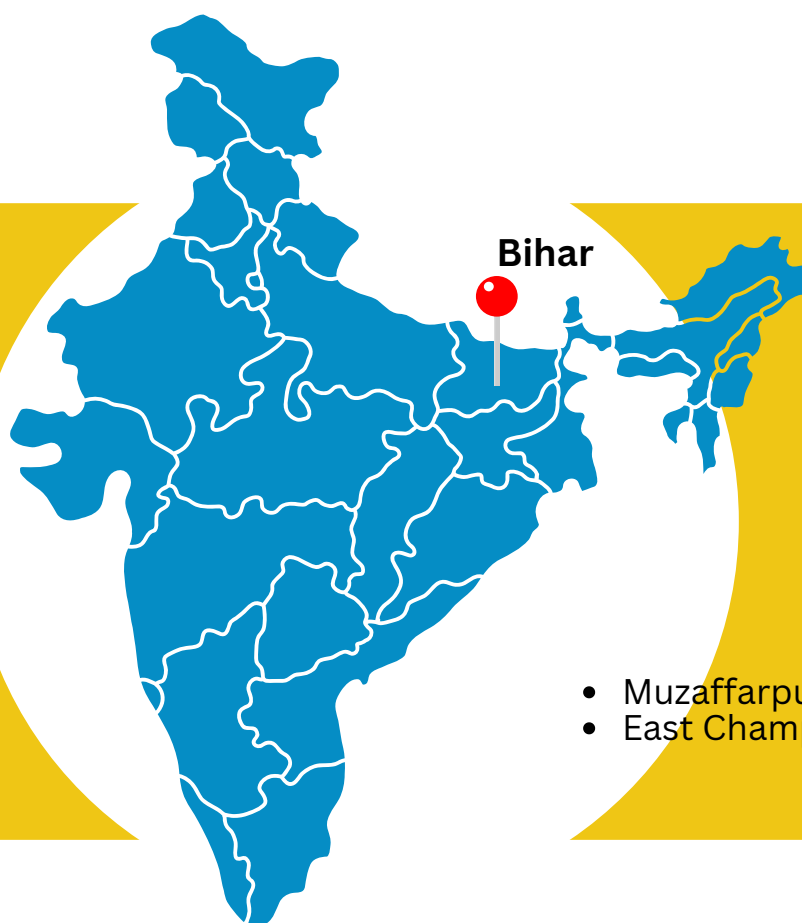
Who we Are

Empowers adolescent girls (11–19 years) from Dalit, Mahadalit, and marginalized communities

Forms 40 peer groups and safe spaces for learning and leadership

Promotes continuation of education and re-enrolment of dropouts

Builds decision-making skills and encourages girl-led community action
